PEER GUIDE PROGRAM and APPLICATION INFORMATION

Peer Guides are Native youth coming together to create community support for those impacted by the Juvenile Justice system. Together they will inspire other youth to engage in cultural prevention to heal our homes.

Have you, a family member or friend been impacted by the juvenile justice system?
Would you like to join a team of peers, like minded, to work together to reach out to advocate for positive change and prevention programming? If so, this program is for you!*

UNITY seeks to recruit twelve outstanding Native youth leaders between the ages of 18 to 24 to serve as Peer Guides for the three-year Tribal Youth Leadership Development Initiative.

UNITY is recruiting youth who have demonstrated leadership qualities and can be depended on to carry through with commitments and responsibilities.

Peer Guides will receive continual mentoring and training to support and prepare them to focus on delinquency prevention and juvenile justice issues in Indian Country and lead Native youth through a series of six regional gatherings and webinars. Those selected will serve as project advisors, peer trainers, and technical assistance for the implementation of youth-developed community service projects related to juvenile delinquency prevention and intervention issues for three years.

Among other responsibilities, Peer Guides will be expected to:

- Serve as youth advisors to the OJJDP; Tribal Youth Programs;
- Help recruit four youth councils to advocate for Native youth impacted by the juvenile justice system;
- Participate in all APeer Guide training sessions, teleconferences, webinars; and provide Peer Guide reports.
- Serve as peer trainers at two regional gatherings to train Native American and Alaska native youth;

TRAVEL

COMMITMENT AND REQUIREMENTS

- Agree to participate in all Peer Guide training sessions, teleconferences, webinars; and provide Peer Guide reports.
- Age 18 to 24 when applying.
- Provide proof of tribal enrollment upon request, from a state or federally recognized tribe.

Applicants must complete and submit the online application form prior to the noted deadline. Please note that only online submissions will be accepted for consideration.


Applications must be received in the UNITY office by 5:00 pm (Pacific Daylight Time) on **Wednesday, April 17, 2019**.
