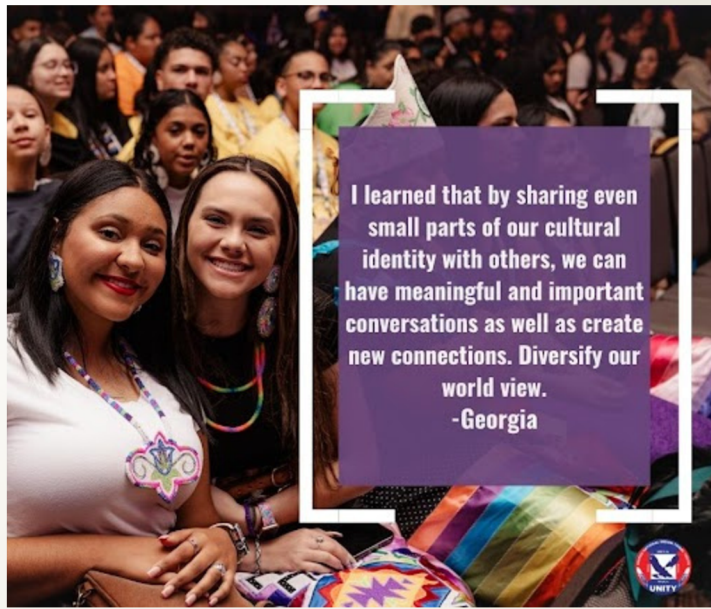

UNITY's mission is to foster the spiritual, mental, physical, and social development of American Indian, Native Hawaiian, and Alaska Native youth, and to help build a strong, unified, and self-reliant Native America through greater youth involvement.

Founded in 1976, United National Indian Tribal Youth, Inc. (UNITY) is a national network organization promoting personal development, citizenship, and leadership among Native Youth.

UNITY's network currently includes 300 affiliated youth councils in 36 states. Youth Councils are sponsored by Tribes, Alaska Native villages, high schools, colleges, urban centers, and others.



UNITY PROGRAMS

National UNITY Council (NUC)

The NUC is the central voice of UNITY, composed of male and female representatives from each affiliated youth council and individual members. It enables Native youth to take a stance on issues impacting Indian Country.



National UNITY Council Executive Committee (NUCEC)

The NUCEC, consisting of ten Regional Representatives and Male and Female Co-Presidents, leads the NUC. It ensures diverse perspectives within UNITY are heard and addressed, representing youth councils and members across 10 regions.

25 Under 25 Leadership Award

The UNITY 25 Under 25 program honors the achievements of Native American and Alaskan Native youth (ages 14-24) who exemplify UNITY's mission of holistic well-being. Online applications open in January 2026.

Earth Ambassadors Program

The Earth Ambassadors Program provides training on environmental advocacy and awareness, equipping Native youth to lead environmental projects. Online applications for the next class open in January 2025.

More than 2,500 Native American and Alaska Native youth from urban and rural communities across the nation will converge in San Diego, CA in the summer for the annual National UNITY Conference. The five-day conference will provide participants with culturally relevant leadership, skill-building training through workshops and keynote presentations.

Each year, more than 300 tribal communities from 36 states are represented at the conference. Participants begin their conference experience at the lighting of the UNITY Fire, a sacred gathering place for culture sharing and healing. The fire stays lit for the duration of the conference, providing a safe-space for congregating and discussion.

The conference will be packed with high-profile presenters and speakers, workshops, health & wellness activities and leadership opportunities. Signature components include the UNITY College & Career Expo with more than 60 exhibitors and vendors, culture night, talent show, 3 on 3 basketball tournament and the annual UNITY Banquet featuring youth awards and scholarships.
