

# INTERNSHIPS

*at the National Museum of the American Indian*

The National Museum of the American Indian offers 10 week internships available at the museum in Washington, D.C., at the Cultural Resources Center in Suitland, MD, and at the museum in New York City. Internships are an opportunity for students to learn about the museum's collections, exhibitions, programs, and methodologies, and to meet professionals in the museum field.

**DATES:** Spring internships begin the third full week of March; Summer internships begin the first full week of June; and Fall internships begin the last full week of September.

**STIPENDS:** An award to offset travel, housing, and other expenses may be provided on a limited basis.

**APPLICATION DEADLINES:** November 15 for Spring, February 15 for Summer, and June 15 for Fall term.

**ELIGIBILITY:**
